NOTE: Agencies with tax exempt status should call hotel directly to insure that you are not assessed taxes).

Ask for "Group Reservations" (group code 23Q4HV) to receive the special rate of \$145.00 per night. All rooms will be charged a daily resort fee in the amount of twelve percent of the pre-tax amount of the daily room rate. The resort fee covers items, including but not limited to, self-parking, Wi-Fi, and reservation processing services. All rates are subject to applicable state and local taxes and fees in effect at time of check-in.
